A CHANCE TO DANCE SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

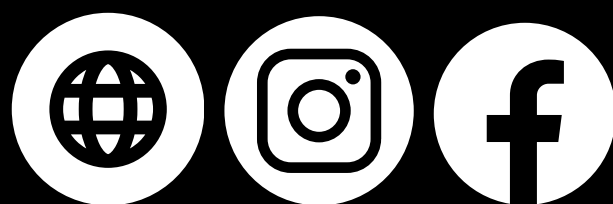
